Our providers treat patients for dental exams including x-rays, dental extractions, fillings, root canals, dentures and partial plates as well as emergency dental care such as a broken tooth, abscess, etc. We offer dental education and consultation.

Our providers are both full-time staff and part-time volunteers from private practices who believe in the mission of Olde Towne to provide access to quality dental care for the community.

Medicaid expansion has allowed the center to provide dental care to even more community members who were ineligible for care in the past. We are proud to continue to offer these much needed dental services to our community.
