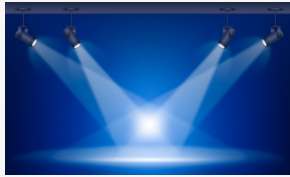

Integrated Care: Primary Care + Behavioral Health Services

Olde Towne offers behavioral health services along with its primary care for adults and children. Many patients who suffer behavioral health issues also suffer chronic health illness that compound health problems for the patient. Having a provider follow both aspects of the patient's wellness integrated together leads to better health outcomes. The convenience for the patient of this duality also helps to alleviate potential barriers to care like the necessity of multiple visits, negative medication interaction and helps a patient build trust with their provider.
